REIMAGINE BOULDER HIGHWAY HITS MAJOR MILESTONE

As we mark the one-year anniversary of the Reimagine Boulder Highway project, we've laid the groundwork—literally—for a safer, more walkable and future-ready Boulder Highway. These improvements may be hard to see now, but they are the vital first steps in a transformation that will benefit residents, businesses and commuters for decades to come.

Here's a look at what we've accomplished since breaking ground:

Better Drainage for Safer Streets

Flood-prone areas near Lake Mead and Sunset are now better protected thanks to major drainage upgrades:

- Installed new underground storm drains
- Built 5 major storm drain connections, plus 45 manholes and 80 inlets

Safer Intersections and Brighter Streets

- Installed new traffic signal wiring at every intersection
- Laid conduit to power future lighting and signal systems
- Added over 100 new streetlights

Stronger Roads and Better Transit Access

- Placed a solid foundation of road base
- Paved new asphalt in the center median for Bus Rapid Transit (BRT)
- Built red concrete bus stops to support reliable and accessible transit

Cycle track paved

Improved Sidewalks and Accessibility

- Added new curbs and gutters
- Poured new concrete for smoother sidewalks
- Installed new ADA-compliant ramps

Upgraded Utilities—Future-Ready Infrastructure

 Relocated all utility lines that conflicted with the project to avoid future disruptions
